Goals and Objectives

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Goal 1. Publish an original manuscript in a peer reviewed source

Objective 1. Prepare a manuscript for publication. This could be writing a chapter of a textbook, a case report, a review of your PI project or participation in original research with publication. This should be done with oversight by one of the Family Medicine Faculty who will serve as mentors for this process. As such, this mentor will be responsible for the evaluation of this rotation.

Objective 2. Identify appropriate peer reviewed sources for submission of your manuscript.

Objective 3. Put your manuscript in the form required by your source.

Objective 4. Submit your manuscript for publication.

Objective 5. Once published, please notify the program coordinator with the information related to this publication (e.g. Pub Med ID number).

Goal 2. Complete any outstanding scholarly activity not previously completed.

Objective 2. Complete any assigned hospital PI/patient safety project.
